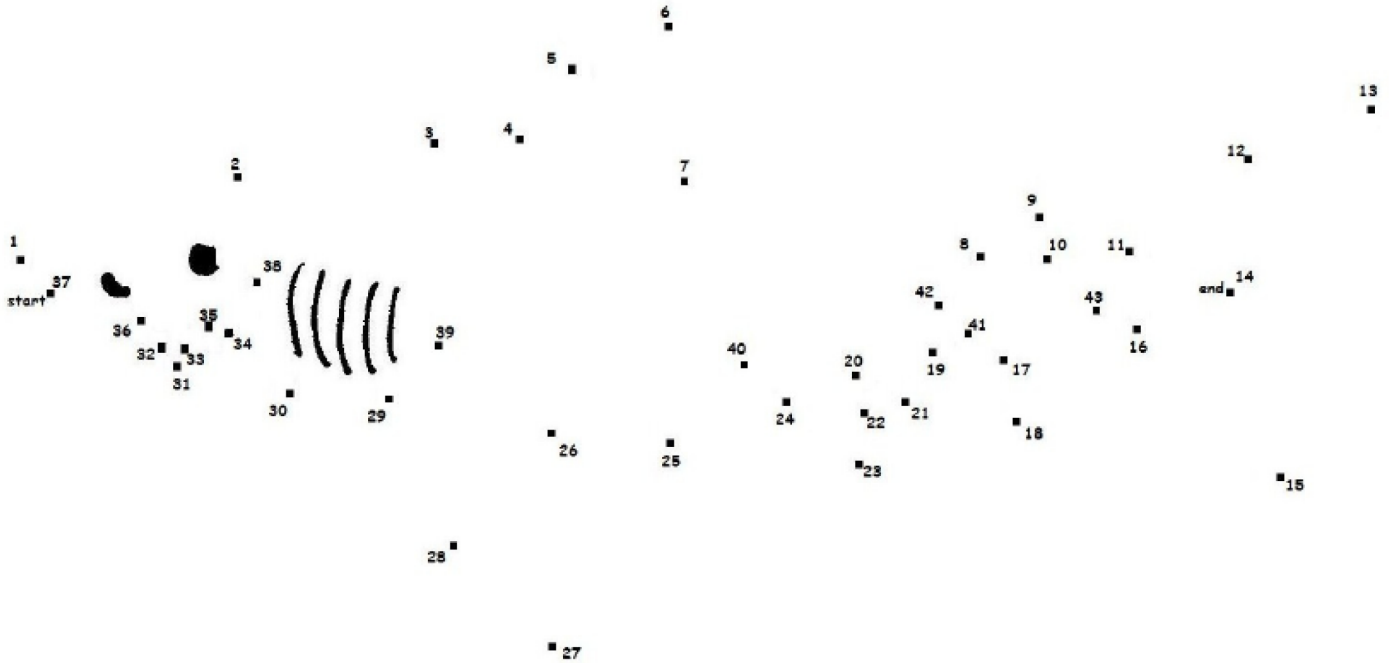


CONNECT THE DOTS

FAST FACTS

Sharks are cleverly colored to blend into their surroundings, like camouflage. The dark pattern of a Wobbegong Shark blends with coral and rocky reefs, and Great White Sharks have counter-shading, a dark top and light bottom. When a Great White is below its prey, it blends in with the ocean depths; when it's above, it blends in with the light of the surface.
